How to book

Whether you are booking one of our activities or visiting us independently, you must book in advance. Please ensure you have the following details prepared:

- Dates and times of your proposed visit
- The activity session you would like to book
- Your full address and telephone number
- Size and age of the group
- Any special needs the group have
- If you need a space for lunch and need to use our lockers
