Key Stage 2

KS2 Gallery Discovery tour **Curriculum links - English & Art**

The Gallery Discovery tour takes your pupils on a journey around the gallery to explore and engage with the exhibition. Using worksheets and stories they will record their ideas and feelings about the artwork, and take the work they have created back to school.

1hr. £55. Max group 25.

Key Stage 3

KS3 Gallery Discovery tour **Curriculum links - English & Art**

The Gallery Discovery tour takes pupils on a journey around the gallery by recording their ideas and feelings about the artwork in their sketchbooks. They will develop their understanding of contemporary photography by exploring ideas with the help of worksheets and small discussion groups.

1hr. £55. Max group 25.

Create an Electronic Sketchbook **Curriculum links - Art, English & ICT**

Using the images in the gallery as inspiration, pupils will work in small groups to create a digital sketchbook about their visit to the gallery and the artwork in the exhibition. Pupils will be given dry materials to work with in their sketchbooks and a digital camera to record images for the digital sketchbook which will be sent back to school.

2 hrs (with a short break). £100. Max group 25.

Key Stage 4

GCSE Art and Design

KS4 groups can learn more about the current exhibition with a Visual Literacy session led by the Education manager. The session aims to give students the confidence and skills to read an image and form personal interpretations of the artwork in the exhibition. Pupils are encouraged to work in their sketchbooks to record their thoughts and ideas about the artwork.

1hr. £55. Max group 25.

Creative & Media Diploma

Creative Media Diploma students are welcome to visit the gallery as part of their research into the Creative and Media offer in the region. Students are welcome to speak to staff about their roles in the organisation and speak to the Education Manager about what activities and events are organised as part of the Impressions programme.

This informal talk is free of charge, but must be booked at least 4 weeks in advance to ensure availability.
