Maud Sulter

1 April to 4 June 2016

Maud Sulter (1960–2008) was an award-winning artist and writer, of Ghanaian and Scottish heritage. Her work looks at the visual imagery of Black women and emphasises long-standing connections between Africa and Europe. This exhibition is the first detailed examination of all of Sulter's work outside Scotland including collages, photomontages and unseen work from Sulter's archive.
