Exhibition

Made over a period of six years, the exhibition offers a rare glimpse of everyday life in Ukraine. Photographer Chris Nunn went to Ukraine to find out more about his Grandmother. The exhibition shares the stories of the people he meet on his journey. Themes include the dynamics of families; masculinity of young men and fathers; freedom and togetherness, and seemingly inescapable ties with history.

Workshop

This workshop focuses on the theme identity. In the first part of the workshop pupils will go on a journey around the exhibition searching for objects and symbols that represent Ukraine.

In the second part of the workshops pupils will be given a range of images and words to help them think about their own identity.

In the final part of the workshop pupils will create and make collages exploring their own identity.
